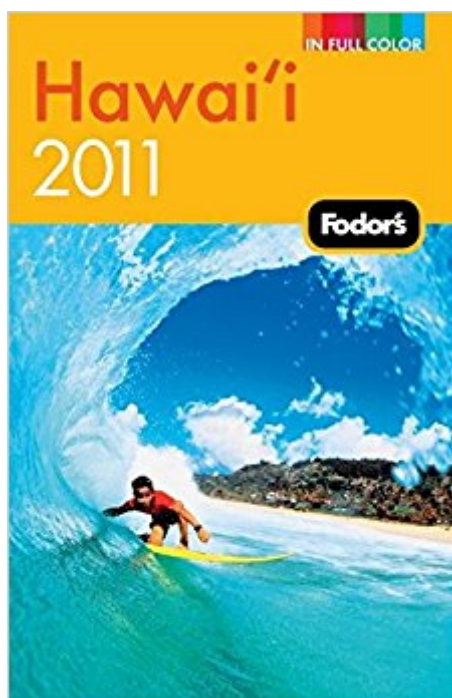

This is a great book for planning a trip to Hawaii. We spent three weeks traveling between Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and the Big Island. It helped use establish a good general plan for the days we would be on each island. We hit all of the great spots the book recommended and were not disappointed. This book is too generic for my tastes. It tells you a little bit of information about a lot of different places, but doesn't do a very good job of rating places. I like the books that have a system that tells you something is a "must-see" or "great to see if you have time" or something like that. I also wish there were more tips about how busy beaches might be and more about the seasons. The book talks a lot about "if you go inWinter...." or "during the Summer..." but there isn't much about Spring or Fall. I also really like books that give you sample itineraries for different cities or the whole state-some even go so far as to tell you different types of itineraries. This doesn't have much of anything. Overall, it might be a good starting point, but is too general to actually be helpful.

This guidebook for Hawaii weighs a ton and is pretty similar to last years copy, same cover photo, but for referencing this or that place it comes in handy. Every year we get the new edition to keep up

with the restaurant reviews. Their writers keep on top of that. We've been to all the islands except Lanai and usually gravitate to Maui or Oahu. The other guidebook we use as a resource for planning our outings is No Worries Hawaii which has pages and pages of the best beaches and hikes for all the islands. Both books offer plenty of advice for seasoned as well as first time travelers and we never run out of things to do since we are there for a good chunk of time.

Read 1/2 dozen books before our trip (from the library) and ordered the Frommer guide as it was clearly superior to this one.

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
