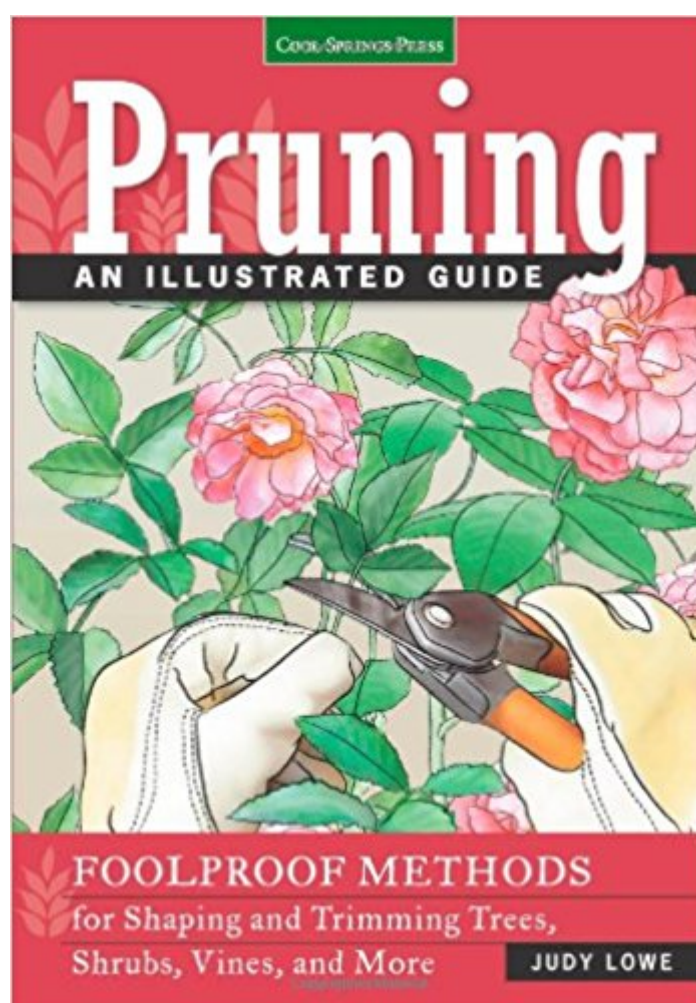


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Pruning: An Illustrated Guide: Foolproof Methods For Shaping And Trimming Trees, Shrubs, Vines, And More
