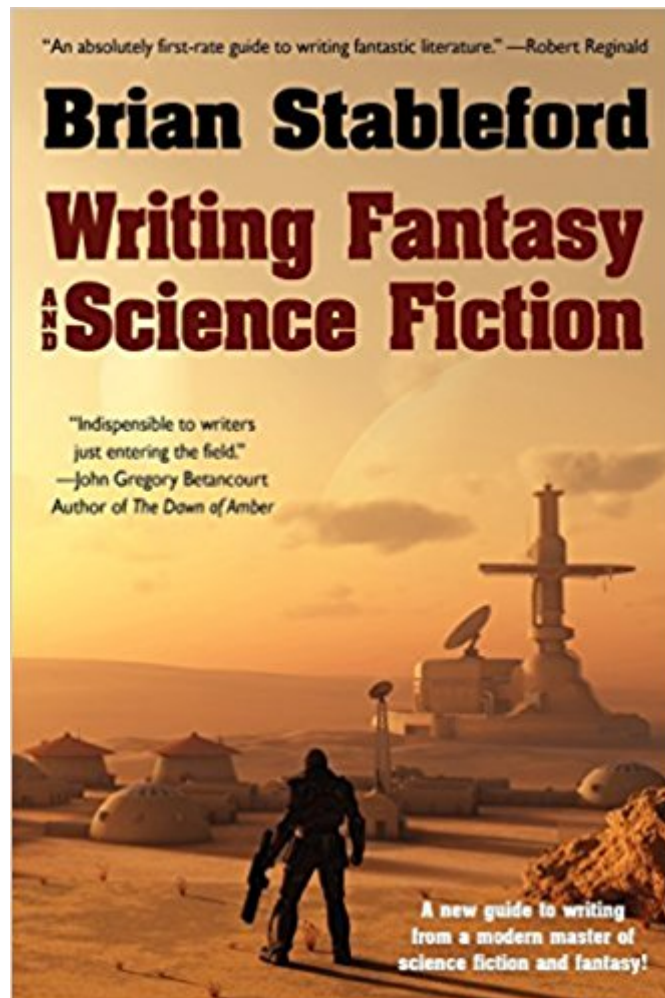

things as is for beginners and didn't teach me anything. I know it is difficult to write guides that succeed on teaching plot elements which is why I recommend the one I mentioned, Most guides out there don't tell you how to improvise on research. Not to mention I am not being picky, I would have given this lower, but maybe the writer tried and didn't succeed at explaining how to plot it. What most writing guides do is tell you this is how you should write this. But we need examples of the technique and exercises, and to be explicit. It might be for you if you think it is worth the price. In conclusion, I would learn from the one book that explains basics well, with examples and a small amount of exercises. I don't like books that try to explain misconceptions. Gives us the "nuts and bolts" but don't spend an entire book not giving what we need to know for a basic manuscript from inspiration. In summary, this won't help as much as you think to go beyond beginner.
