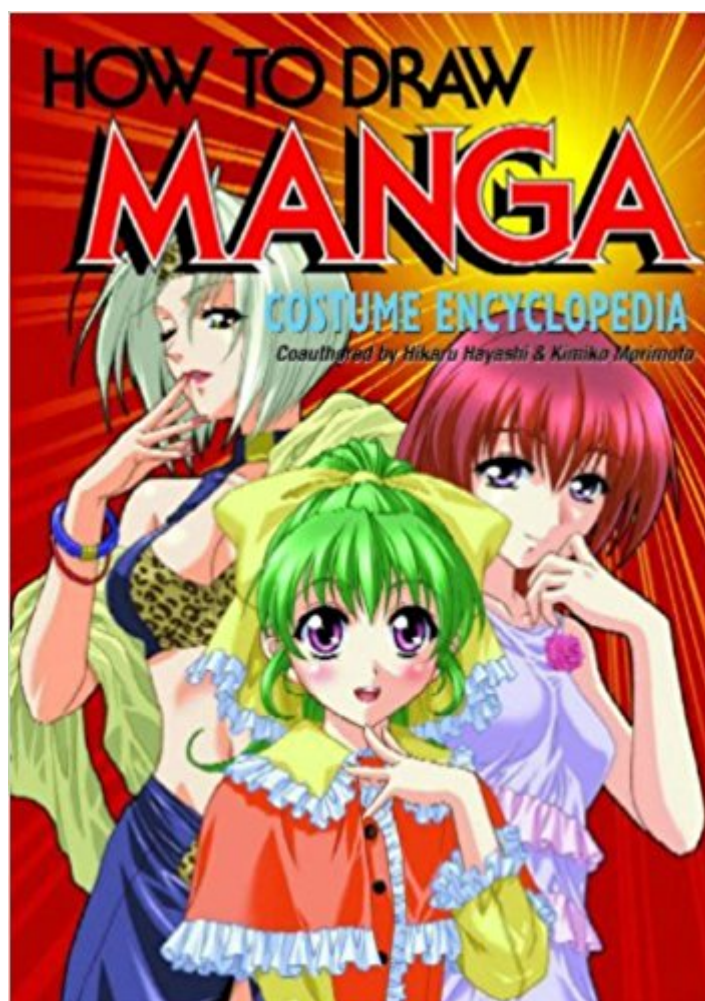




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How To Draw Manga: Costume Encyclopedia, Vol 1, Everyday Fashion

have started to refer to it more I have found it more useful than I first thought. So I'm upping my rating to 3 stars. Some of the drawing are a bit small and I do think they look a bit too much like technical drawings (not much style to them). But overall I am finding it worthwhile to have.

This book provides lots of reference drawings, sorted by type of clothing. What I didn't like was the emphasis on some clothes, that don't really differ from others pictured on the book. The other thing I didn't like was the incomplete drawings. Only the first pages have complete drawings, while the rest have only upperbodies, legs, or fullbodies, but without faces. Given the talent of these artists, it would be very easy for them to provide complete drawings, with faces and expressions that match the poses. Summing up, a very good book, very useful for the manga artist that already knows how to draw bodies, but needs some help getting them dressed. Special note on the final section, about folds.

I hoped to see a good number of illustrations and styles, but I am actually overwhelmed by the sheer number of variations and illustrations in this book. This is a fantastic resource. I definitely recommend it. The only drawback is that the illustrations are generally done in the over-simplified style of this series, but what the illustrations lack in tones and shading is more than compensated for by volume and diversity. There's still no substitute for a good from-life reference, but this book makes it easy to pull from a whole universe of styles. Great stuff.
