want to hurt her best friend? Ethan is a police officer who's assigned to Marianna's case. His sister was deaf and he's always blamed himself for her death. Can he ever forgive himself after three years? After the murder, someone begins to target Marianna. She needs to trust Ethan to accept her for who God made her. After her last boyfriend asked her to get a cochlear implant, it's been difficult to trust that Ethan likes her the way she is. Can God give her the confidence she needs? Only one thought and that was about her service dog. I was surprised that he was not with her at all times. Also a German Shepard has strong protection skills, so I was surprised he was locked in the closet at her apartment. Shepards are wary of strangers. But all for the story line, and a great story it is. Thanks Ms. Eason.

Yes it is a "short story" compared to other books I have read by Lynette Eason but that does not detract from the quality character development and the great plot line. I am most impressed by this author's attention to factualness in her stories. It is very clear in the accurateness of the police references, the forensic references and the character development. This is the first novel by Eason I have read that has a character with a physical handicap. She is very truthful in portraying the independence and capability of her heroine, even though the heroine is deaf. Once you read one of Eason's books you too will be hooked on her skill and want to read everything she writes.

I chose the rating because the story began a little confusingly. Also the action developed too slowly that it became a bit frustrating. Part of the problem could have been the distractions of our 70-pound dog with bathroom issues. I'll have to be more liberal in the next review. Thanks Lynette for such a

captivating story line.
