

The design will encourage browsing; the paper is thick, the type clear, and full-color photographs, maps, and charts appear on every double-page spread. The in-depth discussion, which will be great for reports, includes coverage of early conquests, such as the genocide and displacement of the Herero people from southwest Africa, as well as recent conflicts in Zimbabwe and elsewhere. A contemporary photo of Johannesburg brings home the continuing postapartheid split between the affluent and the poor. The island of Madagascar, with its unique flora and fauna, is also part of the story.
