Most teenagers have enough to deal with, just being teenagers. But Maddie here, well, she's something special. The road to Nationals isn't easy if that's the only thing you have to deal with, but Maddie has school...and a job with her little sister...and a boyfriend...and coaches changing her

routine...and interviews, media coverage, social media...and haters. Like every teenager, and every person for that matter, Maddie has her doubts and insecurities. But she also has incredible drive and determination, awesome talent, and family and friends to stand by her even when what comes out of their mouths isn't what she wants to hear. The author's writing style is easy to read and her characters are definitely relatable. I give Thin Ice a thumbs-up and will have to check out the first two books in the series as well.

I've read all three Skating Series books and this is the best one. Maddie faces a lot of conflict and stress on the way to the National Championship. She consistently doubts herself the whole way yet pushes herself to be the best she can be, which is a great lesson. I hope that this isn't the last of the series, or that Sarah writes a companion series with a much older Maddie on her way to the Olympics. I would recommend this series to anyone who loves figure skating.
