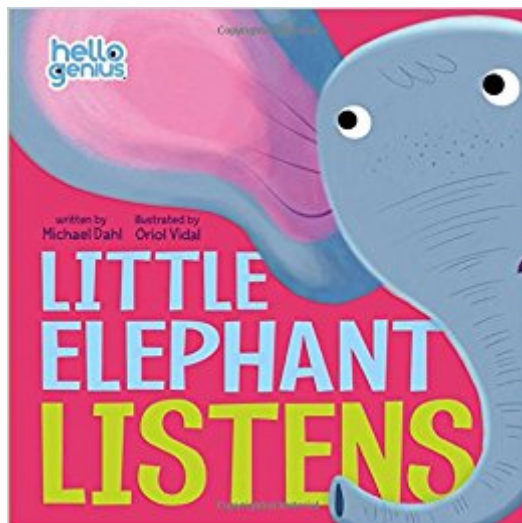

Michael Dahl is the prolific author of the bestselling Goodnight, Baseball picture book and more than 200 other books for children and young adults. He has won the AEP Distinguished Achievement Award three times for his nonfiction, a Teacher's Choice award from Learning magazine, and a Seal of Excellence from the Creative Child Awards. And he has won awards for his board books for the earliest learners, Duck Goes Potty and Bear Says "Thank You!" Dahl has written and edited numerous graphic novels for younger readers, authored the Library of Doom adventure series, the Dragonblood books, Trollhunters, and the Hocus Pocus Hotel mystery/comedy series. Dahl has spoken at schools, libraries, and conferences across the US and the UK, including ALA, AASL, IRA, and Renaissance Learning. He currently lives in Minneapolis, Minnesota in a haunted house. Love these books and I'm sure we have almost every one of them by now. These are easy for my daughter to follow along with and learn from. Started reading these to my daughter when she started biting at about a year and she's been picking different books from this series for the past 8 months when it's story time.

My 2 and 1/2 year old son loves this series of books. I bought all of them because I think the concept is great: teaching kids the right thing to do. My son loves the colorful images and silly things that happen in them. They are short books and do not have too many words on the page, which makes them nice and quick for reading time. I tend to read 3-4 of these each night at bedtime. At this time I can't say they are 100% effective at behavior changes, but having him listen to the story does allow him to hear what is "right." I assume that it will sink in eventually! I will come back, and edit, once I can determine if they make a difference in my child.

This is the only "listen" type book I could find. I like the time to eat page but who needs to tell a toddler it's time to play??? There are much better examples to use. Toddlers don't use a loufa on a stick. My daughter thinks it's a toothbrush. Half the book is useful.
