

Although this is only one title in the Understanding Iran series, it is quite comprehensive in its discussion, including more than just clerics. For instance, the book begins with an introduction to Islam, including the differences between the Sunni and Shi'ite branches. There is also a history lesson, starting with the Ottoman Empire and moving through the reign of the last shah. The American-organized coup that overthrew a legally elected Iranian government in the 1950s is also examined. When the book gets to religious leaders and how the Iranian government is organized, the text becomes a little dense. Fortunately, an accessible format and a layout filled with many interesting color photographs encourage readers to keep pushing. An extremely helpful book for report writers, this also works for anyone who wants to understand how and why Iran functions the way it does. Solid back matter, including reading lists, sources for further information, and a glossary, add to the book's usefulness. Grades 6-9. --Ilene Cooper
