

I ordered the loose leaf version of this book, 8th edition. The words in the text that should be bold are just a shade lighter than the regular text. It is difficult to distinguish between the regular words and the "important" words. It would have been better if the words were bold or underlined to make them easier to see. This common text feature is missing from this version of the text book. It seems like a small problem, but it does make it difficult to study with this text book.
