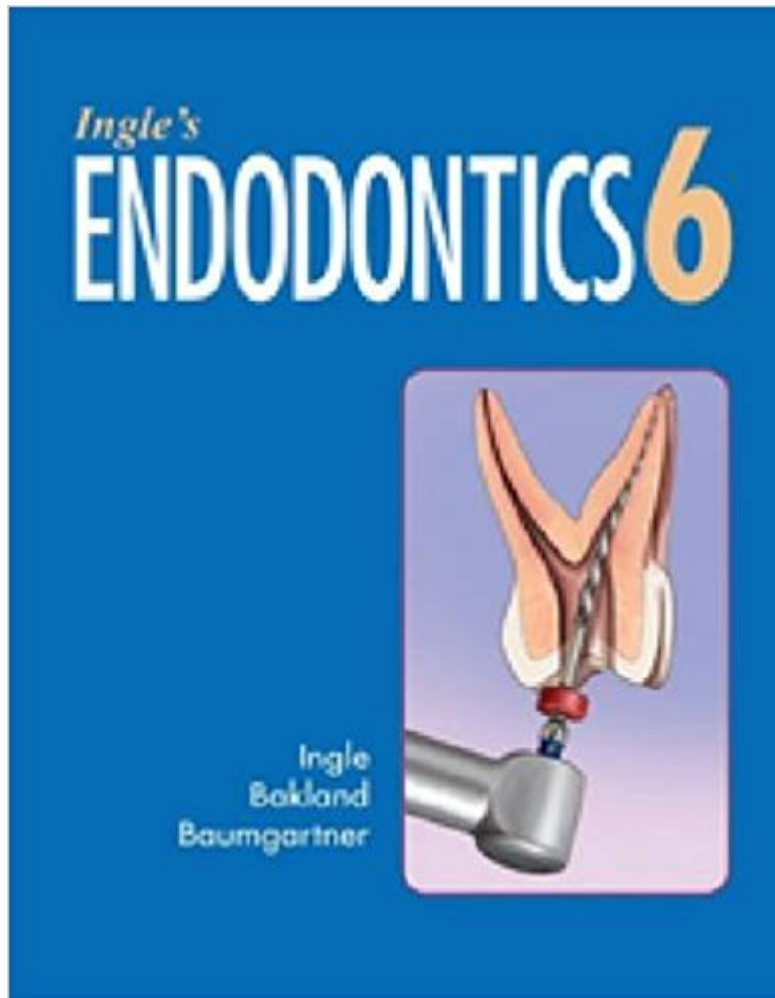

This is THE current encyclopedia of Endodontics. The chapters are written by the "big names" in endodontic research and publications. Includes even the latest (as of 2009) about endodontic regeneration procedures. Unfortunately, the index is poor, almost useless. There is information in the book not listed in the index, and some entries in the index reference the incorrect page of the text. So... to find what you are looking for, you have to decide which chapter should cover that topic, then skim the chapter to locate the information you need.
