

Okay, I have lots of word. BUT ONLY GOOD WORDS. Autumn Doughton is my superhero and her books not only speak to your soul, but they are chalked full of life lessons that stick with you forever. And since I can never tell which author wrote which character/part of the story, I guess this all goes for Erica Cope as well. I loved Bash and Amelia's story SO MUCH that I was CONVINCED I wouldn't be able to love or appreciate Seth's story. But this one blew my socks off and really had me loving Seth and Imogen (such a great name) just as much, if not more than Bash and Amelia. I'm a sucker for road trip/scavenger hunt/not-inst-a-love-but-falling-in-love-on-a-quick-yet-doomed-timeline stories, and this book was all three combined into one. Seth is so much more than a guitar playing guy who is standing on the precipice of stardom. He is genuine, soulful, hilarious, patient and so kind. Imogen is so much more than an obsessed ballerina. She is flawed and hurt, but so much more willing to take a chance than she even realized. Together, they are perfect; two missing pieces that fit better than anyone could even imagine. Their story will make you smile and laugh as much as it will make you want to cry out in anger and frustration. But let me assure you...it is all worth it. Always. Side notes: Imogen's mom is one of my favorite characters and I hope I can be as amazing as she is when I grow up. Also, I feel like Imogen's house is what Autumn's home is like IRL. Like that character and that setting are EXACTLY what I imagine Autumn to be like AND NO ONE CAN CONVINCE ME OF ANYTHING DIFFERENT.

I was excited to read this because Seth was a great supporting character in The Bright Effect. I didn't love this book as much as that one, but I still really enjoyed it. The story surprised me, as the entire book takes place in about 24 hours, but there's quite a bit that happens. Seth was great, I loved his character! Funny, sweet and lots of fun. Imogen was a little much at times, especially her anger at Seth, it seemed over the top. She also exasperated me about the situation with her dad (especially after the whole story is revealed), but then I have to remember I'm coming at this from the perspective of someone old enough to be Imogen's mother. The book was a nice balance of fun/adventure, romance and family drama. Seth's family history was particularly heartbreak, I kind of hope he pops up in another book so I can see how he's doing. I really don't read much YA stuff but as long as Autumn and Erica keep writing books this good, I'll keep buying.
