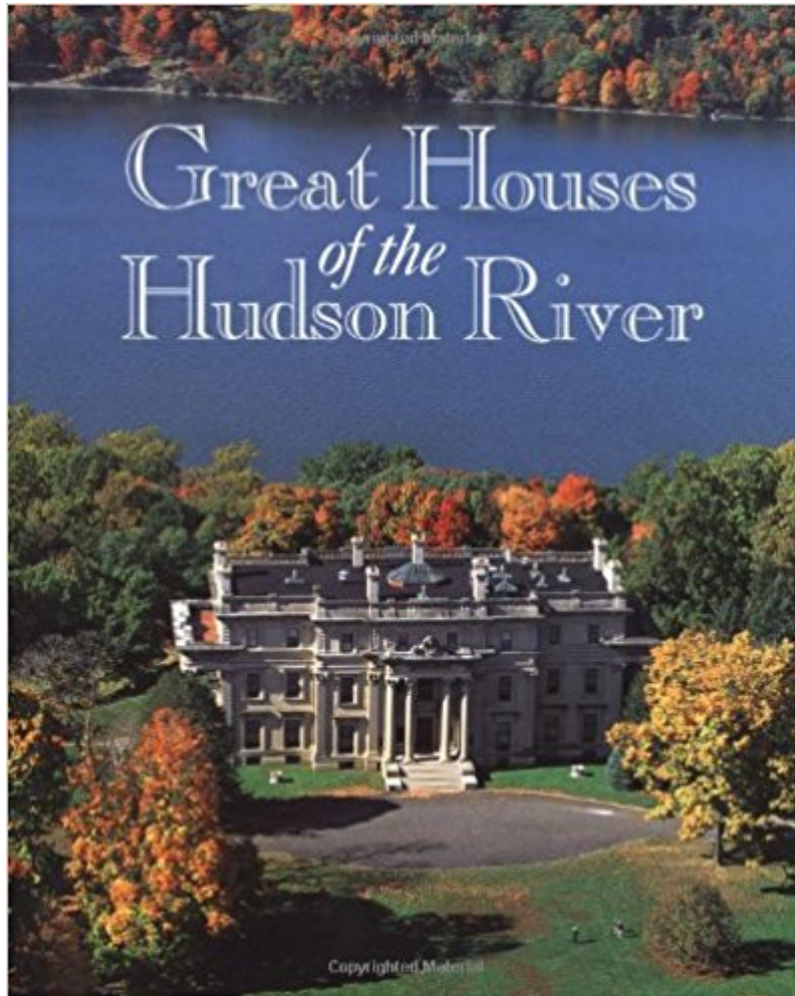

Mark Rockefeller is the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Historic Hudson Valley.
