

I gave this a 4 because I love ALN's writing, and have high expectations for any series she puts out. Piper isn't my favorite, but liked her evolution as the story went on. There were times where she seemed like a total pawn, but as the story progresses she finally starts to take things into her own hands and I'm looking forward to see her taking more control in a lot of ways. There seems to be a

lack of depth in emotion when it comes to Piper and Merc, but we haven't yet seen these two interact beyond the bedroom or battlefield so I'm hopeful we'll see more progress there too. This oversimplified relationship makes it hard not to love Knox all the more just because there are those smaller moments and banter, but there's a pawn-like element in Knox's instant devotion to her. Overall a good read even if a rough-ish start to this series, but left intrigued and still wanting more.

I really liked this book. The story was well thought out and the characters were strong. The action was good but I would have liked to see a bit more of a description of what was going on with her magic. I would recommend this book to anyone.
