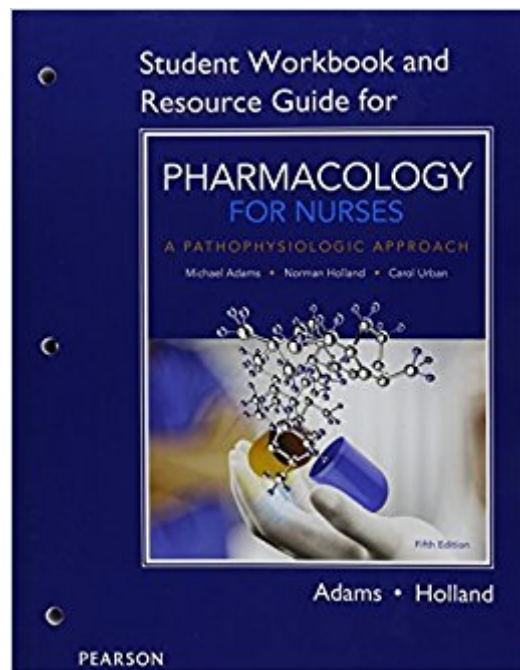

The answer key in the back of the book is not accurate. Example, Chapter 4 has 30 questions and the answer key only goes to 26. And questions that are multiple choice, are then given essay responses in the corresponding answer key. I spent more time trying to figure out where the correct answer was than actually using it as a study guide.
