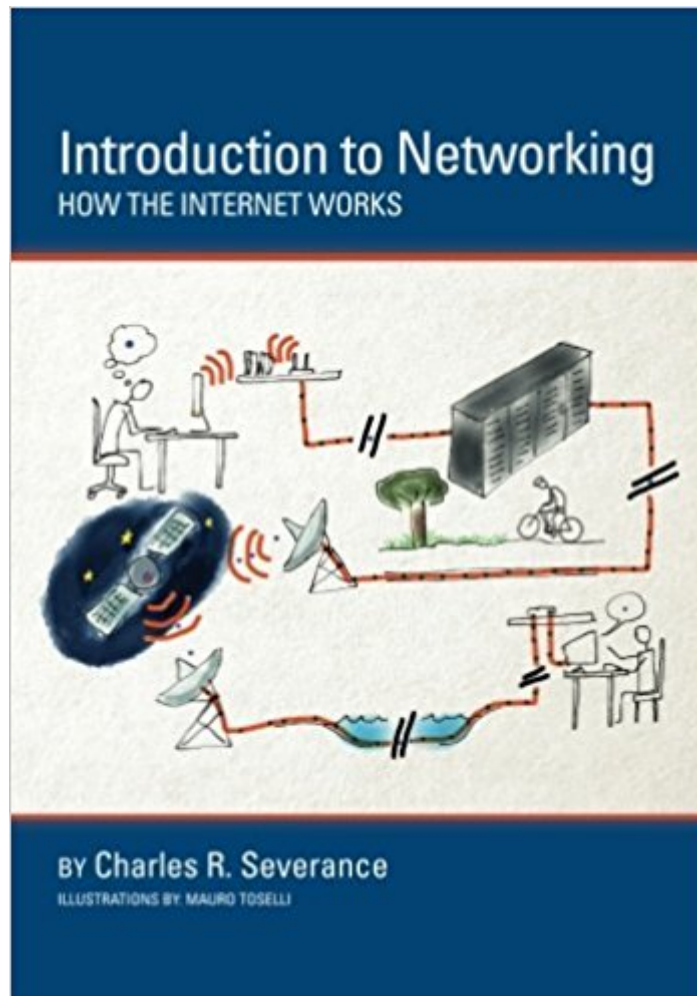




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Introduction To Networking: How The Internet Works

Mission accomplished. Book provides a good overview of TCP/IP. I'm not an IT professional but reasonably technology literate. This book provided some practical insight to what's going on in the background in a manner that's easy to digest.

Although I had a general concept about how the Internet works (ip addresses, routers, etc...) this book did an awesome job of progressively building up the concepts from the ground (hardware) up to the user level (an application like a web browser or and email client). It saved a lot of the confusion OSI abstractions until the end. Highly recommend this book, very accessible but also informative.

The book is concise, and provides enough context, history, and examples to make it very easy to

understand the problems that early network engineers were trying to solve. Highly recommend this book as an entry point for learning how network infrastructure works.

Some have complained that this text does not include many of the finer details of networking. To those, I would argue that's not the point of this book. I have the paperback. I have read portions of this in pdf format. Both are great. The illustrations are simple, but effective. If you have next to no knowledge of networking, having this book under your belt (should not take you longer than a week or so to read through, at a leisurely pace), reading through this will ensure your acquaintance with the various concepts which you will later delve into further with other networking textbooks, which can often be dry and dull. The author does a marvelous job of keeping the various concepts fresh in your head so you can tie them all together. To get lost in the details so early in the game could be counterproductive to your integration of these concepts.

I'm a web programmer and just wanted to know a bit more about networking. The book was written in a very understandable way. Many fundamental concepts are introduced, but without too much jargon. Can't think of any cons.

It's a basic and clear book on how the internet Works. Also it's the perfect companion to Dr. Severance's course on Internet History, technology and Security in Coursera.
