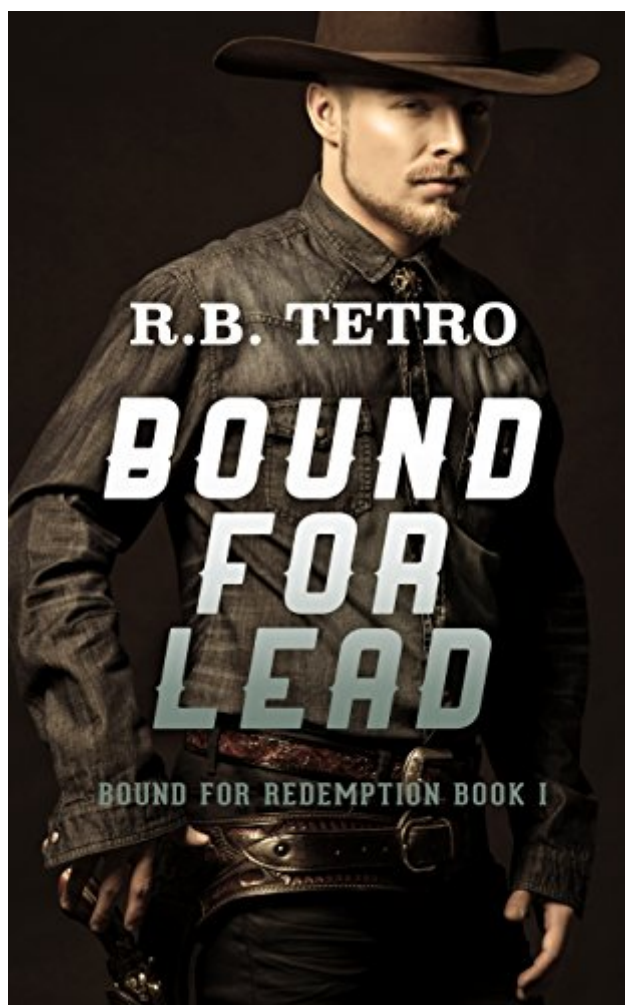


The book was found

I pretty much agree with many of the other reviewers. This story was written in a disjointed manner & in some places it didn't even make sense enough to follow the story line. For instance...when Tommy arrested Tom I thought maybe it was a misprint. The inconsistencies marched through the book to the point that I found myself wondering what the heck the story was even about. I read about two-thirds & finally gave it up as a lost cause. I don't like to not finish a book that I've paid for but I would rather read a good book twice or even three times than to read a bad book once. This book was definitely not worth the time I spend on it. Sorry!

Love this book. It is a very good western, well written, well organized, and very enjoyable!

This story is poorly written and the writing is very stilted, juvenile and dispassionate, as if told by an uncaring outsider. The author does not set the stage for the reader, so you are often left without any idea of what the teller of the story wanted to share. . Mr. Tetro should have hired someone to edit the book for him before allowing it to go to press. It is my guess that this is a self published book and a very good example of why most authors should not self publish. I would not recommend this book. One excerpt: "Benny stood. Jacob stood. Seth stood. Each of them had their hands on their guns." This style of writing is used through out the book. In another section of the book, the doctor has an injured woman wrapped up tightly, "like a cocoon" to keep her from moving, a short while later she is "throwing up her hands and shaking her head." Several chapters later, the doctor comes in and tells her that she is well enough that he can "unwrap you today." This is just one of the glaring inconsistencies in the book.

Spelling errors that got distracting. Weak, glossed-over gun-fight scenes. When I read a western, I want detailed gun-fighting scenes. Would not recommend.

I received a copy/ARC for an honest review. I began reading this western and another book at the same time, and could not decide which book started off with more despicable, evil men mistreating other human beings. This novel starts with the evil men torturing an old man and thoroughly enjoying his fate. This novel gets more hopeful as other people are introduced to the readers, but there is much evil spread by numerous characters. There is a war against evil, but the duality of good vs. evil even has a losing battle in religion as shared by the author. Finally, after a massive gun

battle, it looks like the good guys have won, but the novel ends with NO HEA. The ultimate vision of the author is of depressing evil overwhelming good. While the book is well written (except for the inability to distinguish between homonyms, like their, they're and there) it is ultimately a paean for evil triumphant over good.

Little did bounty hunter Jacob Clay realize just how far he would be drawn into a bloody land war with small ranchers pitted against Jacob's vicious killer brother and his large band of hired killers. A crooked judge adds to the mix and the bodies of men, women and children, begin to pile up when murder rides the range. It's all about the power, the hired gun-slingers, the oil and lots of money. Can quiet merchants, professional people, small business owners, and fleeing ranchers with their frightened families stand a chance against such heavy criminal odds? Plenty of twists and turns in this harsh story about hard men and the women who stood beside them. Well worth the time.
