I love the snarky humor as Lee puts it that just keeps rolling in this next segment. I threw this in my urban fantasy collection along with the first one in the series and found the story just as engaging. Ms. Lee does an excellent job of capturing a young adult attitude and mixes it nicely with a supernatural set of characters. In this second story, the main characters all gain more depth and I think a reader of this genre will be quite satisfied. Also, unlike many of the stories I've downloaded, this one is very clean in its presentation - I think someone actually did an edit pass. I like the way these stories are centering on more mundane events and not end-of-the-world scenarios.

Fun reading about Zoe and her trials and tribulations of just out of high school drama life and right into the drama of college life. My only fault with the story is that there wasn't any wrap up with Lisa the Ghost. As the entire premise of the story was about Lisa the Ghost along with all the other missing girls, one would think there would be a wrap up of what happened to her after Zoe solves the murders. Even the Epilogue didn't really mention what happened or maybe I missed it in the Boy drama and Girl drama in the college dorms.
