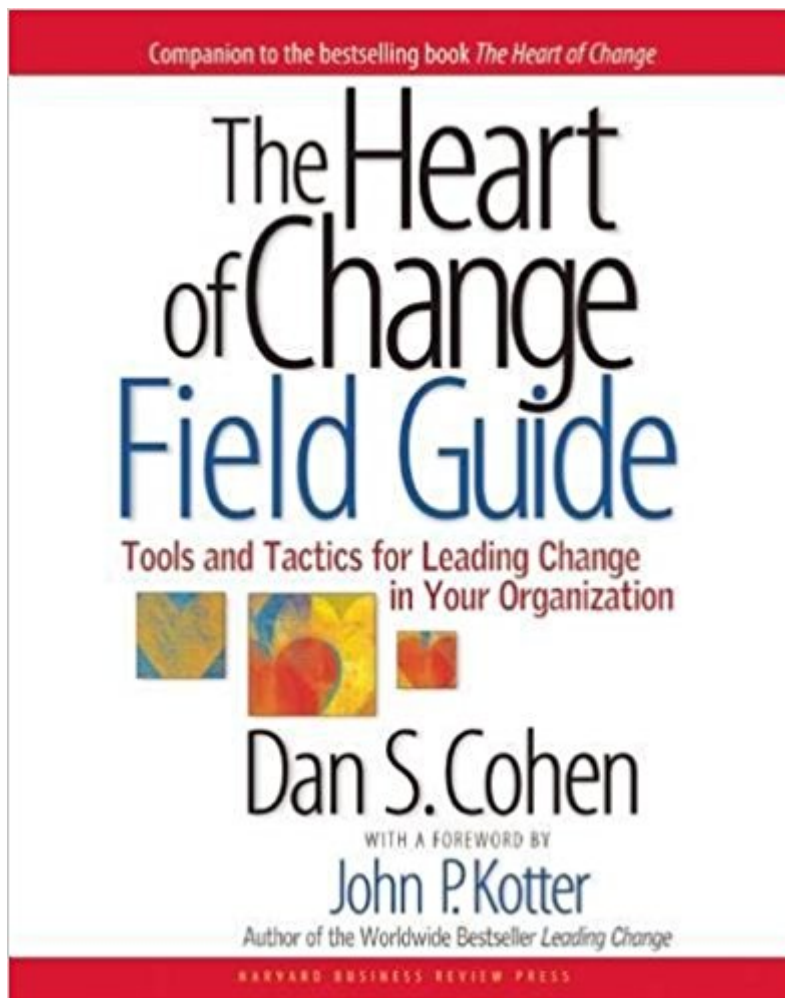


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The Heart Of Change Field Guide: Tools And Tactics For Leading Change In Your Organization
