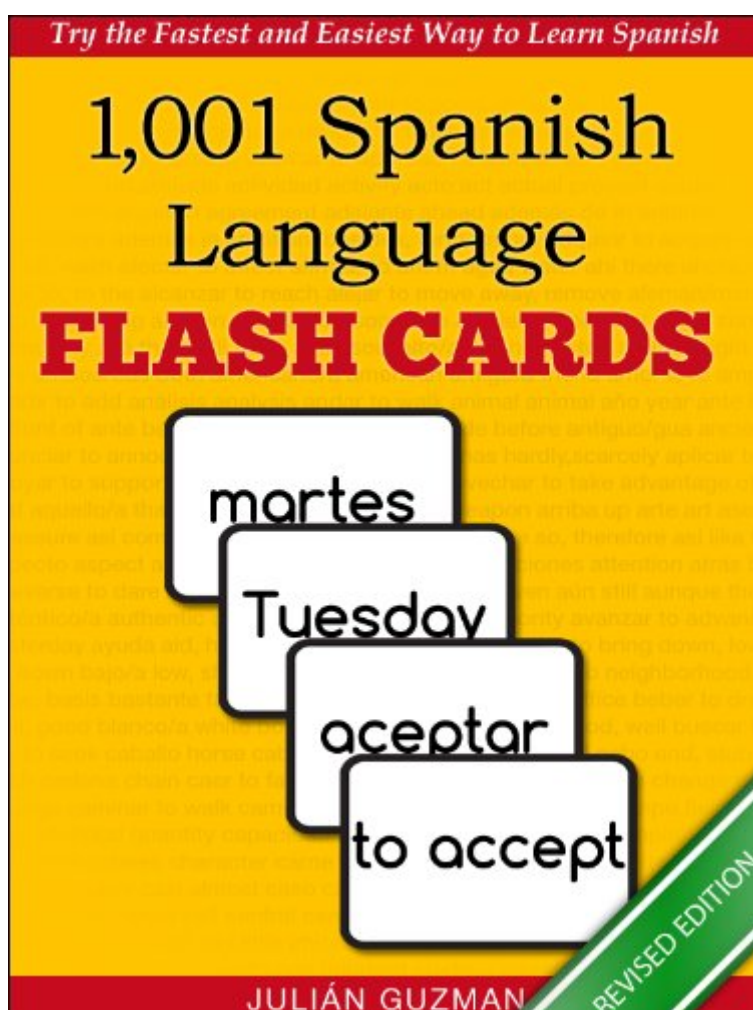

At the time of purchase there were two other Spanish Flash Card products on the Kindle marketplace and as none of them were especially expensive I bought all of them. Of the three, this is the only one that appears to have been written by a real teacher, the only one that didn't contain glaring mistakes and subsequently the only one I kept. The inclusion of the pronunciation for each word is very useful and makes practicing the language very easy. I'm actually starting to think that there are a number of other topics that I gave up on trying to learn that would be worth trying with flash cards too as it's a format that really works for me and I'm surprised by just how much information I've been able to retain and recall in such a short space of time.

I tried to find a link to contact the author because it looks like this could be a very good book, and I haven't gotten far, but there are errors near the beginning that maybe he could correct in the Kindle version (I don't know if it's from a problem in the to-Kindle conversion or also in the book). I started reading through the adjectives at the beginning of the book, and found lots of instances where the pronunciations were for masculine & feminine forms, but the forms themselves were both written the same (in the masculine form). Examples: (sorry, I don't have Spanish accents handy) autentico, autentico [ah-oo-ten'-te-co, ah-oo-ten'-te-cah], enfermo, completo, concreto, definitivo, directo, distinto, duro, extrano, extremo, historico, junto, justo, lento, menudo, mismo, perfecto, pleno, politico, practico. I think the phonetic pronunciation is a great idea - I would change the Spanish "i" phonetic, as in autentico, to "ee" instead of "e" - an example is in autentico - "te" would be pronounced with an English short e (as in "telephone") instead of the English long e. "tee" would represent the long "e" sound heard in the Spanish "i". I would love to talk to the author if he's

interested....

I'm a rank beginner in learning Spanish, so take that into consideration. On the plus side, I'm a rank beginner in learning Spanish. I've been looking for something simple and straightforward to use in getting accustomed to Spanish nouns and verbs, and this is the best I've found so far. It also contains adverbs and adjectives, by the way. Each word is presented in its Spanish form with a pronunciation guide (not with weird marks but in a way that an English speaker can understand) and a brief definition for the word. Nice and concise. I actually started with Rosetta Stone but quickly got frustrated at not having a convenient way to learn a little more about each word, and this seems so far to be a good back up for the Rosetta Stone exercises.

This is a very good list of the essentials and a bit more. The beginning part of the book is the condensed list of all the words. Then the actual flash card style presentation is at the end. If you are reading on the desktop reader it begins on Location 694. The Spanish word is presented first and the English word on the next page. The book appears to have been updated from prior reviews that said the flash card version was not included; or they didn't scroll toward the end of the book.

Well worth the price. It starts with a quick summation of pronunciation, followed by a glossary divided by word type. I was disappointed thinking this was the flash cards. But eventually you get there. My only wish is they had done them both ways. I wanted to read the English and state the Spanish translation. Why not both ways? But, if you are learning the language, this is a great quick practice on a plane that you can refer back to repeatedly and quickly. I finished in one quick plane ride and will now refer back on other plane rides. One of the many tools to use to learn languages particularly in Kindle. I like it.

Learning languages has always been my passion, but the lack of time and money never allowed me the luxury to study as much as I wanted. Sometimes life is unfair, especially when it doesn't allow you to follow your dreams; but sometimes it also saves the best for last. And that's exactly what happened to me. An early retirement and some plans for traveling that me and my also retired husband made, gave me the opportunity to bring to life, with a few decades delay, my dream. We were planning to travel to Mexico, and even though the Spanish language there is a little bit different from Spain itself, the basic words and phrases, as I came to understand, are about the same. But how should I start learning? I knew a few words, but surely they wouldn't be enough to offer much

help on our journey. I had no choice but to look for a book, and that's exactly how I ended up with the one at hand. It promised a lot, but would it deliver? That question never left my mind until I finally hit the Buy button and it appeared on my screen. I was pleasantly surprised by its simplicity and with the way Professor Guzman treats his subject. I felt as if he wrote this book especially for me, explaining in detail what I should do, how I should do it, how to ask questions and how to respond to them. In the end this guide proved itself to be the perfect companion for us on our journey.

For people who are trying to make the Spanish language their second language, this is a most useful tool. Even if you have only a few minutes a day you can go through one section of flash cards to test your knowledge and pronunciation. This tool is especially effective because the instructor is Spanish speaking and a teacher. He grew up with the language. I have several core texts that help with Spanish and the flash card fits well with them. It's sight, sound, writing, and practice that makes you fluent, and comfortable. Dictionaries and translators are nice to have, but of little use if you don't recognize the correct word and pronunciation.

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
