

Discussion of methods behind each study encourages critical thinking about key

concepts. Retelling of complex contemporary research in a simplified form is the first step in teaching the skills required for understanding current professional journal articles in psychology. Up-to-date research allows students to see the current state of psychology. Several classic studies illustrate important historical roots, but the text focuses on information from the last decade. New topics in this edition include: the outcomes of children of gay parents; the influence of context on homogeneity and heterogeneity biases; the relationship between self-esteem and aggression; and the effectiveness of token economies.Â Â
