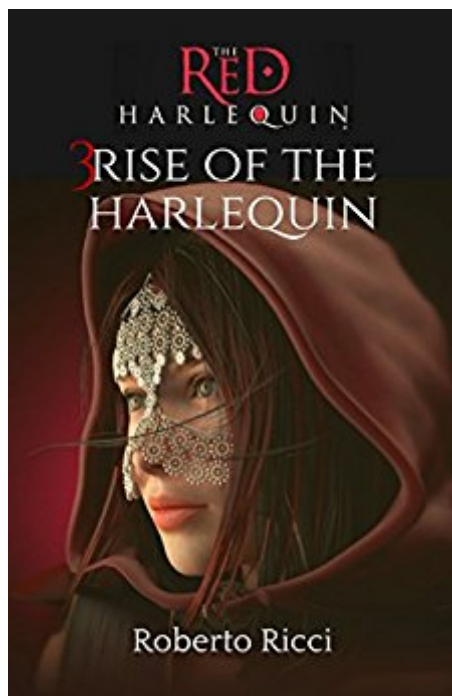

These are not the world's best-written books, but they entertain. The writing is very uneven: pretty good in some places, cringingly vague and awful in others. Overall, it's about an 8th-grade reading level. They should have marketed these as children's fiction, it definitely isn't "adult"-level material. Nevertheless, for idle reading, it's alright. And it's only \$2.99 per installment.

Have enjoyed reading the Harlequin series. Interesting twist on an old theme; however, a couple parts of the stories did not make sense and scream of lazy writing. First the central character, the Red Harlequin, falling in love with the princess was instant and as romantic as a pancake and second the Red Harlequin goes from being a young boy to a warrior skilled enough to not only take on professional soldiers but he also beat them but the author never explain where the 'boy' gained the warrior's skills, experience and courage. All and all, the Red Harlequin series is a fun read.
