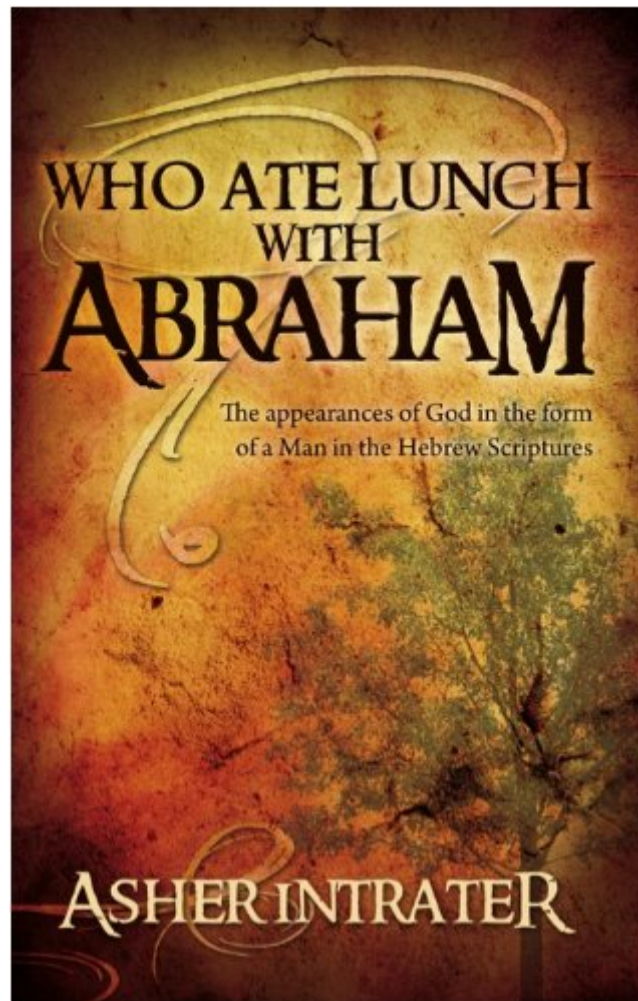

I had recently "discovered" Genesis 18 after reading another book (The Gospel According to Moses) and really wanted to read more into it. I was just amazed that I had never really read this chapter as Jesus having visited Abraham and just read it as another "nice" story in the Bible. I happened to come across this book and felt the need to order it right away. I am so happy I did. This book just really blessed my life, especially in the way I read things in the Bible now. I now look for "clues" as to other spots He is mentioned in. This book starts out with Genesis 18 and goes on to other places throughout the Bible where Jesus is mentioned. This author is a Messianic Jew, and knows the original Hebrew that the Bible was written in. He has really done his research and shown so many places where Jesus is really front and center. I DEFINITELY recommend this book to anyone, that is anywhere in their walk with Jesus. It is really great. I ended up reading it then a friend bought it and now we are working on maybe doing a Bible study with it because we just can't keep the excitement to ourselves!

I had heard about this book, that it covered who the mysterious figure called the "Angel of the Lord" is. That was something I wanted to know more about, so I began to read...To my shock, not only is the Angel of the Lord clearly the same One who would later be called Yeshua (Jesus), but He is also the Voice of the burning bush, the One who wrote the Ten Commandments and the exalted God of Isaiah 6. He is all over the place! How little I realized before reading this book that every time God is seen or heard, it is Jesus, before the incarnation revealing God to humanity. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

I have found the book very valuable. As a Messianic Jew who was raised Jewish I realized that

there were several times in the Old Testament that God came down to earth in the form of a human to meet with Abraham and Jacob. But this book made it clear to be that there many more. The book also divided the visits by God in two categories: first as a man with all of his glory as with Moses where one could only see God's feet, and second as a mortal man, similar to Yeshua (Jesus). I found that this book offers great proof for Jews to understand that justification of believing in Yeshua. The author of the book has written an excellent reference book. It is well worth the money I paid and much more.

Wow.....not even 5 chapters into this book and I'm floored enough to be able to recommend this. Well written and organized. Asher has an and extremely high understanding of The Hebrew language. He also has a great understanding of the "Going on's" within the Old testament.
