

I really find this book informative, I have tried several of the techniques with good success.

The directions are clear and easy to follow.

Rather perverse choices of sculpture...a lot of grotesque and sick minds on display. Twisted and unusual may be original and hip but it does not necessarily indicate creativity. While art doesn't have to be pretty but it shouldn't be a display of a depraved child run amok with some sculpey materials. The projects are few and, except for a wall piece which consists of a box with some simple objects which are unremarkable and unidentifiable and does not belong on any wall (maybe the iron curtain as it was being torn down) the other projects are short and steps are missing. Some of the titles of the pieces are motivational but there are many other much worthier books...perhaps why the library dumped it and the only checkout was in 2001. No one else bothered the borrow it. So in great untouched shape.

Loved this inspirational book. I am a beginning clay sculptor and found that the first several books that I read on the subject were too technical and uninspiring. This one is exciting. The ceramic sculptures in the illustrations are so creative and beautiful and the author's clear and concise writing accompanies them perfectly. I love the projects and the step by step instructions and illustrations that go with them.
