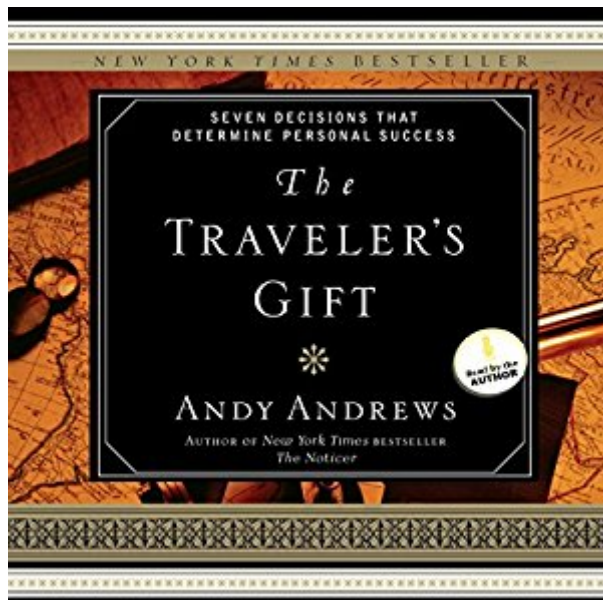

What a surprise! I rarely read a book I literally can not put down. I read it in two days. Of course over a weekend. I feel every person should read this book. What a great gift for a graduate, a birthday even Christmas! The story has a real life lesson and even if a younger person thinks when they read it is "just a book", they will always remember having read it. I wish every student either enrolling in college or graduating, should have to read it.

While this may well be a work of fiction, the lessons that are imparted are very real, and very applicable to everyday life. We get mired down in the events of our past, becoming stuck and unable to move forward, reverting to a culture of "blame the others" and failing to take responsibility for our actions. I know, it's easy to do.... I've done it myself. The same is true of the protagonist in the story. He gets an incredible gift to go back (and forward) in time, meeting 7 remarkable figures in history that show him that he alone holds the keys to his destiny, and that if he is to move forward, he must give up and let go of his past... and embrace it for making him what he is today. I cannot recommend this book highly enough, especially for teens. This was a book club selection, and many of the participants found themselves reading it to their children. I found myself one night reading virtually every part of the book to a coworker. She then went and purchased it on her Kindle, and could not put it down, despite me having read the majority of the book to her!! If you are looking for some insights into where you have been, and where you want to be, read this book!!! There are accompanying study guides and discussion questions: get them!! They are very helpful to allowing you to put the 7 Decisions to work in your life. This book is a very quick read. I read it initially on a

four hour flight from Chicago to Seattle, and have gone back and reread it twice since then (mid-April). If you are serious about taking stock of your life and changing the course of it.... read this book!! You won't be sorry.

This is a life changing book written with a compelling stretch towards a future of success by becoming the person I was destined to be. I have met different people who had some of the qualities spoken of here... And my greatest choice was to stay close to them because I knew they were real. This book is an encouragement to press on in every thought, attitude, or reaction to become a person who lives a life of being real. I did not want this book to end.

One of the best books I've read this year and my book club agrees. The book was creatively written mixing fiction with some of the greatest men who ever lived. The book gave very important lessons on the skills needed to better one's life.
