

I would highly recommend this book (and series), to anyone interested in the sword and sorcery genre!

Have thoroughly enjoyed all 3 books so far. There's enough character development to enjoy getting to know endric and dendril. The mehrahil are very endearing and creative. I hope he names the cub andril and it stays with him. There are several typos and sentence fragments, but otherwise perfect series. Would love to not wait until October to read more.

Usually I skip writing negative reviews, but I had to on this one... the latest chapter in the Teralin Sword series essentially abandons all characters except Endric and it feels like Mr. Holmberg just needed to get something to print to meet a deadline. This book can't have been read by an editor. It is rife with grammatical flaws, and not just misspelled/misused words. There are whole sentences that just don't make sense. It's sometimes even hard to tell what the intention of the author was based on context. Do yourself a favor and avoid this book. The previous two books in the series were much more satisfying than this one. Hopefully Mr. Holmberg can return to form in book 4.

Endric is a hero. I love and enjoy every thing about this series. The only negative I have is the books are to short. I want more but have to wait. The only thing I can say about that is, it's always worth the wait.

I enjoyed reading this book as much as all the others and am looking forward to reading the next book and am looking forward to seeing what you do to make it as exciting as this one was.
